

The Media Galleries Template for Lotus Domino Quickr

Is designed to assist users to add media gallery functionality into a Quickr Place by dynamically building XML to pass into a media gallery.



There are 3 Galleries in the Template - Audio, Photos and Videos

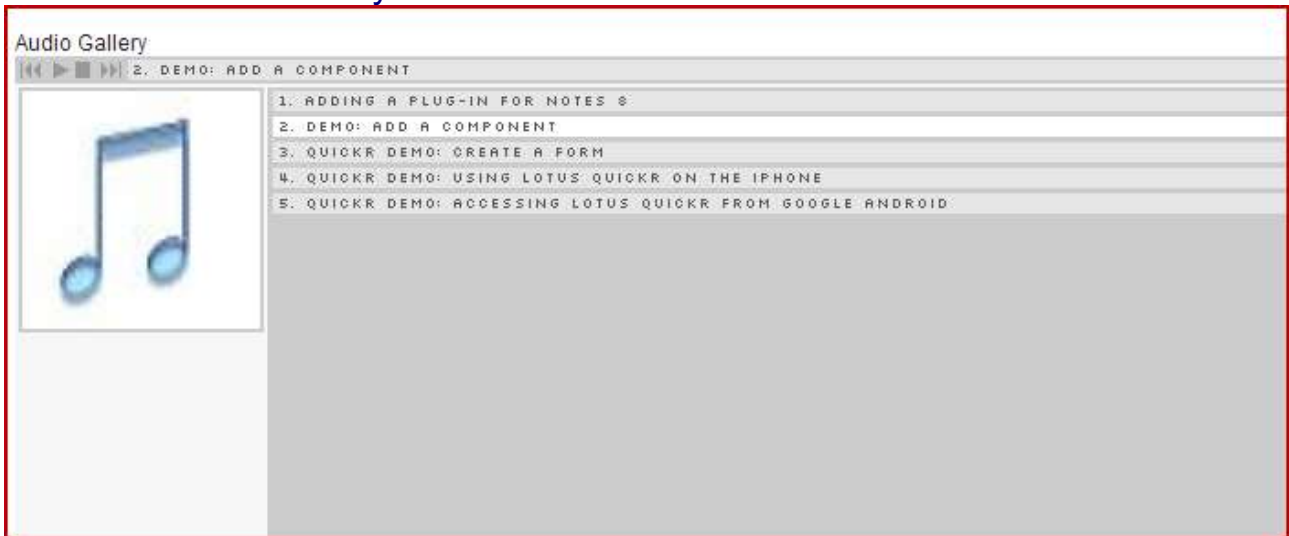
Each gallery takes an XML feed which is constructed from the pages saved in the folders

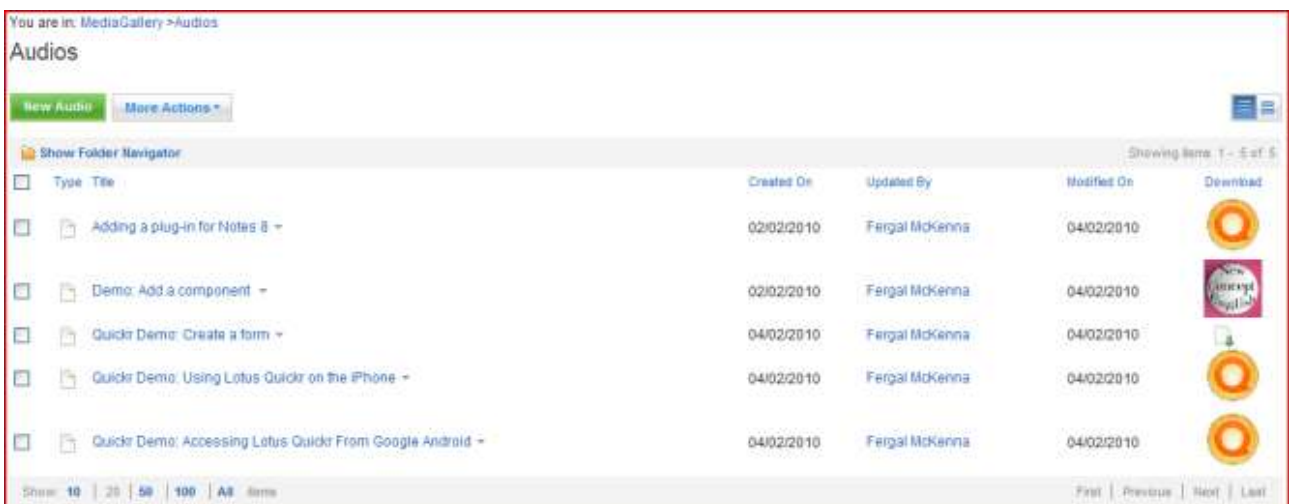
The Audio Gallery

What the Audio Gallery looks like...



The Audio Gallery has its playlist populated from the Audio folder by using Domino\Notes design to create a view and a view template form so that when opened, the view and form will dynamically build the XML file. This XML data will then be fed into the player to create the playlist.

To populate the Playlist, the audio files are stored as pages in the Audio folder.



There is also an option of adding an image with the MP3 files, this will then be displayed as a Thumbnail in the Player and under the Download column in the Audio folder.

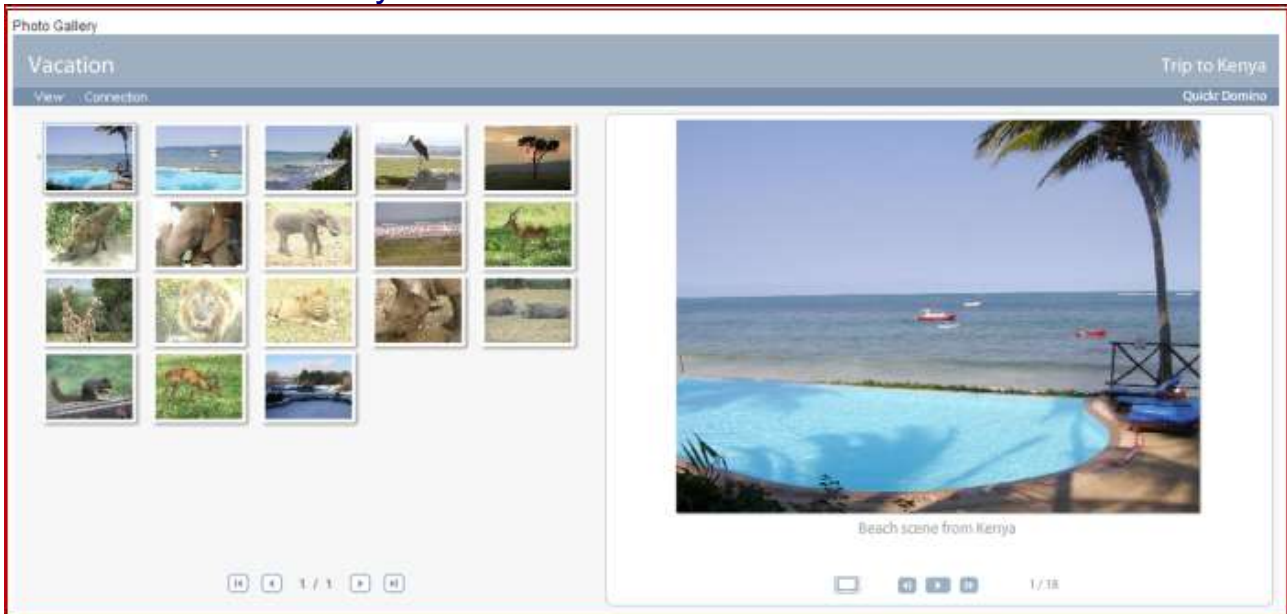

To populate the Gallery, the photo files are stored as pages in the Photos folder. The Images stored in the pages will displayed in the Photos folder under the Download column.

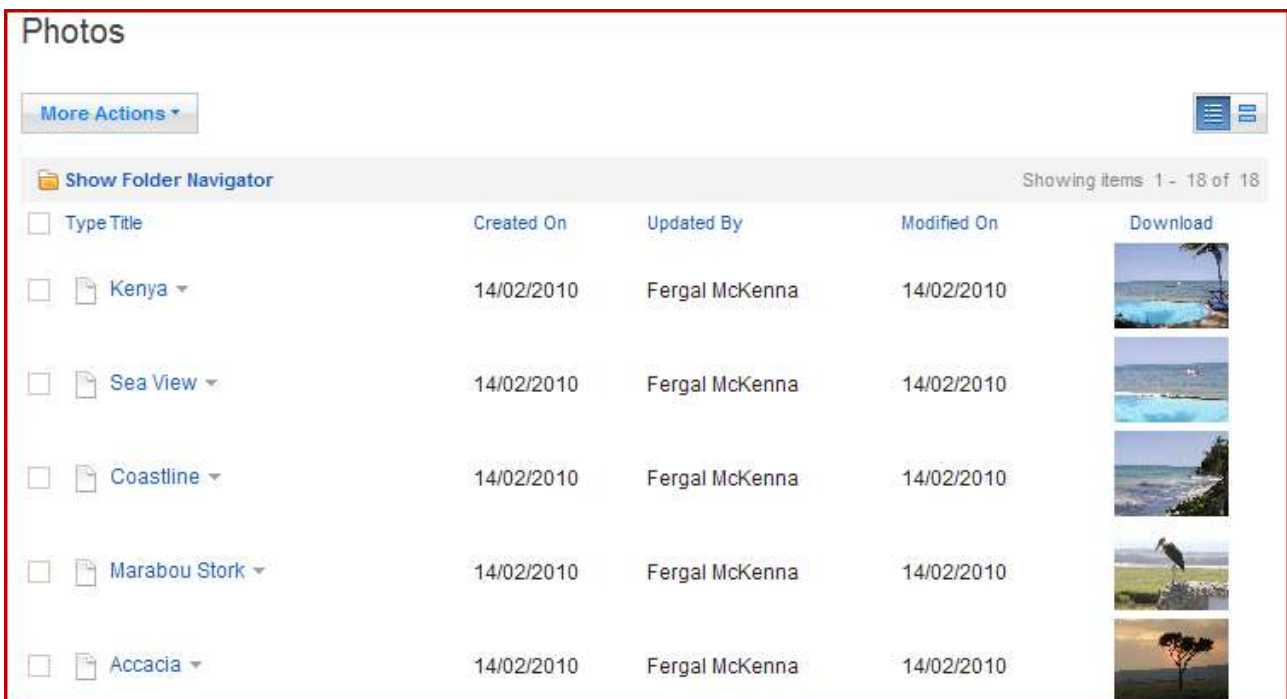

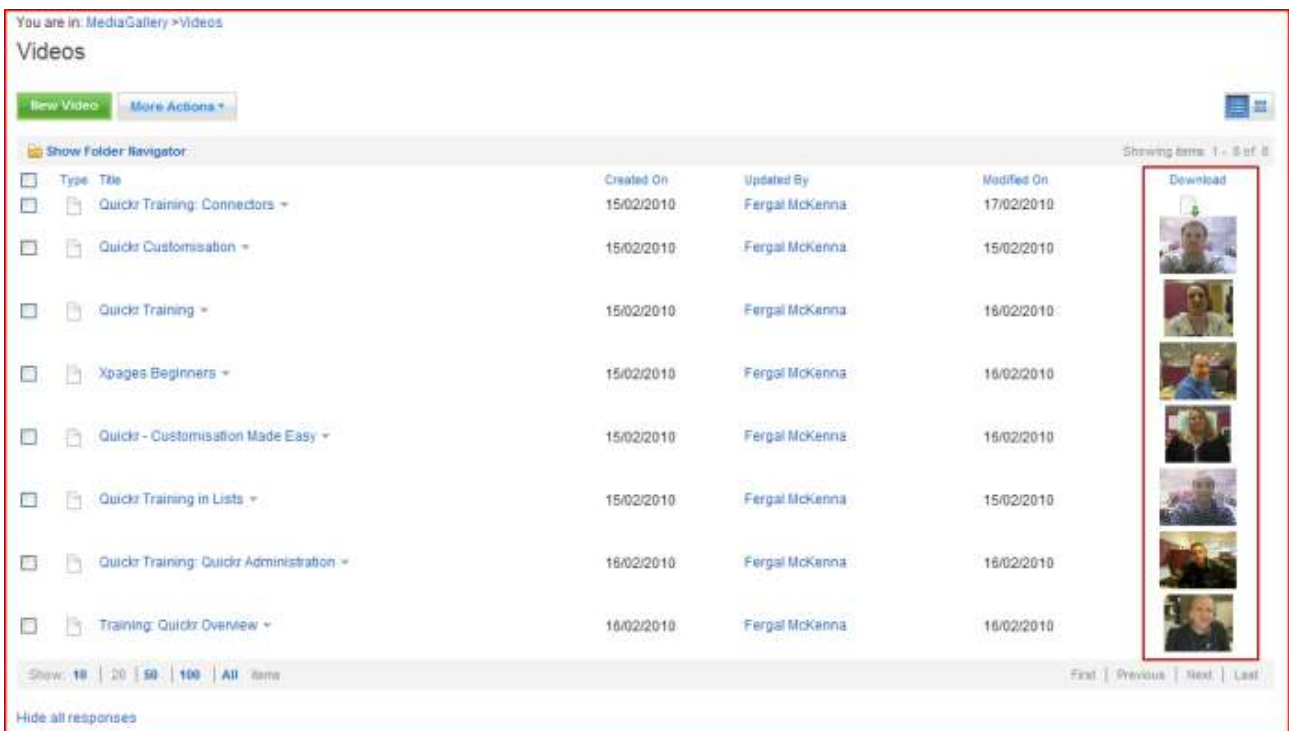
The Video Gallery

Installation Instructions

1. Copy qphtml\skins\quickr81\scripts\Quickr81_ext.js to <Domino>\data\domino\html\qphtml\skins\quickr81\scripts\Quickr81_ext.js

Or add the following text to the end of your current quickr81_ext.js

```
if (typeof(doj) != "undefined") {  
    if (typeof(G_PlaceType) != "undefined" && G_PlaceType == "Media Gallery") {  
QuickrGeneralUtil.loadSupplementalScript("/qphtml/skins/quickr81/scripts/  
Quickr81_ext_thumbnails.js");  
    }  
}
```

2. Copy qphtml\skins\quickr81\scripts\Quickr81_ext_thumbnails.js to <Domino>\data\domino\html\qphtml\skins\quickr81\scripts\Quickr81_ext_thumbnails.js
3. Copy qphtml\video*. * to <Domino>\data\domino\html\qphtml\video*. * - Create the video folder if it doesn't exist
4. Copy mediagalleries*. * to <Domino>\data\lotusquickr\mediagalleries*. * - Create the mediagalleries folder.
5. Restart the Server
6. In the Domino console launch the following command to register the place.

>load qptool register -install -p mediagalleries
7. Log into the place on the server using username "template" & password "template" by adding this username and password to the directory which you authenticate on.

If the username and password don't allow access then use a Super User which can be setup in the QPConfig.xml
9. Add new members to the Place from your directory.
10. Sign the 3 PlaceBots with an Id that is allowed to run agents on the Domino Server.
Click on Customise,
Click on PlaceBots
Select each PlaceBot and sign each one of them
